### **Using the Community Ethics Network Toolkit towards Meeting the Canadian Council on Health Services Accreditation (CCHSA) Standards**

This workshop will provide an overview of the review process for demonstrating your organization's ethics capacity as per the new CCHSA Accreditation guidelines; as well as demonstrate how you can use the Community Ethics Toolkit as the core of your ethics program.

During the first part of the workshop, Susan Burns, Manager of Quality and Risk at COTA Health will provide an overview of the review process under the CCHSA Qmentum Program. This overview is designed to provide you with a core understanding of processes necessary to confirm the functionality of your organization's Ethics Program.

Using this understanding of the CCHSA evaluation/review processes, the second part of the workshop will look at how you can use the Community Ethics Toolkit as the foundation to build a functional Ethics Program. David Gibson, Director of Human Resources & Organizational Development at Bellwoods Centres will review the various steps required in an Ethics Program.

This workshop has been designed with practical tools and suggestions for community agencies of all sizes to utilize to assist in maximizing the use of the Community Ethics Network Toolkit within your own organization. The intended outcome is to provide some functional assistance towards meeting the leading standards in ethical decision-making which can also support the quality delivery of services across your entire operation.
